

## Lanzarote - Cycling in the land of volcanos - 8 days

Enjoy a ride through some of the most dramatic landscapes to be found in Spain and Europe. This Lanzarote bike tour is a unique ride through some of the most dramatic landscapes to be found in Europe. The island is marked by its volcanic origins and suffered a series of eruptions in the 18th century. The results are fascinating landscapes with volcanoes and lava flows everywhere. The architectural works of César Manrique form a valuable complement to the volcanic environment and are a must to be seen. The benign climate, neither hot in summer nor cold in winter, means that cycling is possible all year round. And last but not least you will discover the impressive and unique vineyards on volcanic ash.

### Day 1: Arrival in Costa Teguisé

Today you arrive in Lanzarote. Transfer from the Arrecife airport to the hotel. The rest of the day is free to enjoy the beach resort of Costa Teguisé.

### Day 2: Costa Teguisé > Haría, ~33 or 51 km (21 or 32 miles)

Pick up and fit bikes after breakfast and off you go. Visit Manrique's famous works such as El Jardín de Cactus, Los Jameos del Agua, El Mirador del Río which form an integral part of the volcanic landscape. You also have the opportunity to visit the volcanic cave of La Cueva de los Verdes. You take in fishing villages without losing sight of the impressive Monte Corona. Finally you arrive in the picturesque village of Haría surrounded by its uncountable palm trees.

### Day 3: Haría > Teguisé, ~33 or 52 km (21 or 32 miles)

From Haría, you take the road down towards Teguisé, the one-time capital of the island. Your route gives you spectacular views down over the coast. Teguisé itself is a delightful small town with typical architecture and many pleasant bars for refreshment. From here you continue towards San Bartolomé and the fascinating wine-producing area of La Geria to your hotel where you spend the next two nights (in or near Teguisé).

### Day 4: Roundride from Teguisé, ~50 km (31 miles)

Today is a free day spent in your rural hotel. You can choose to relax, or enjoy a round ride, or even both. Your round ride takes you towards the beautiful beach of Famara with the spectacular backdrop of volcanic cliffs. After following the coast, you head across extensive lava fields and a lunar landscape back to Teguisé.

### Day 5: Teguisé > Playa Blanca, ~50 km (31 miles)

From Teguisé you head towards the island's main attraction, the Parque Nacional de Timanfaya. This is where Lanzarote's volcanic nature is at its most spectacular. The eruptions of 1730 and 1736 buried around a quarter of the whole island, including several villages, and gave rise to the impressive lava and volcano landscape that you can see today. From here you head down to the south of the island, stopping on your way to visit the seaside volcanic crater of El Golfo before you finally reach the seaside village of Playa Blanca.

### Day 6: Playa Blanca > Playa Blanca, ~36 or 70 km (22 or 44 miles)

Playa Blanca sits at the very south of the island and looks across to Fuerteventura. Today you can take a boat across to Corralejo and enjoy a visit or a ride on another island. Alternatively, you can enjoy a day in Playa Blanca and take the opportunity to visit the nearby coves and beaches of Papagayo, the best on the island and still untouched by tourism. Another option is to visit El Golfo for a seafood lunch by the beach.

### Day 7: Playa Blanca > Arrecife, ~50 km (31 miles)

From Playa Blanca, you head across the dramatic hills of Femés before heading to the wine country of La Geria. Here, the unusual vineyard cultivation techniques have given rise to a fascinating landscape not to be seen anywhere else in the world, and producing some fine wines. You then descend to the coast and follow a nice promenade from Puerto del Carmen to Arrecife with its charming inland harbour of El charco.

### Day 8: Departure and transfer to airport or extra nights

A short taxi ride of 4 km to the airport brings you back to your flight home.
